Closed Session

Motion by Comm. Neils and seconded by Comm. Ganser to convene in Closed Session. Before voting on the motion, Comm. Adams announced to all present that the Commission may convene in closed session one or more times during this meeting, upon a motion duly made and carried, the Commission may convene in closed session pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(c), Wis Stats., for considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility, specifically to discuss the refilling of a vacant Customer Accounts Clerk position AND Section 19.85(1)(e), Wis Stats., for deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons, specifically to discuss a pole rental agreement and to specifically discuss a Distributed Generation Application form submission.
